Guild Jury Procedure

Show applicants will be selected by jury. The work will be juried on the basis of workmanship, originality and its appropriateness for exhibition in the Greater Barre Craft Guild Show.

The decision of the Jury Committee will be final, however, an explanation of decision will be gladly given. Categories of crafts will be limited, but waiting lists are maintained. If categories are filled, your jurying is good for a two year place on the waiting list. A non-refundable fee of \$10 is charged for jurying.

No items from kits are acceptable. Items not juried by the Guild may not appear for sale in your display. All crafts must be your own.
